Strawberries on 903 is now registering for the 2018 Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program. Please review the information and if you are interested in the program, fill out the attached registration form.

Subscribers will receive a box of produce each week of a 12 week season, running from May 1 through July 27, 2018. The assortment of produce will vary throughout the season and contain a wide variety of seasonal items. Due to the unpredictability of farming, we cannot guarantee any specific item. We do not customize individual boxes; however, we will accept your requests for more of an item for canning, freezing, or for a special event. Charge for additional items will be based on quantity ordered. Please give us a week's notice for special requests.

Subscribers can purchase Community Supported Agriculture Agreement – Grower Agreement for 12 weeks for \$260.00. The prices of the produce will reflect values of seasonal items. All registrants that pay before March 1st, will receive a \$10 discount off the \$260 fee. All registrations after March 1st, will be \$260. April 15th is the deadline for sign-ups.

Subscribers are responsible for picking up their boxes at the designated pick-up point. We will have multiple pick-up sites and dates depending on the number of members. We ask that each member pick up their boxes on the designated day that you have registered for. If a member will be away (i.e. vacation or business travel), they are encouraged to find friends or another family member to pick up their box, as we are unable to credit missed pick-ups. Please see the registration form for proposed pickup locations. If you miss a weekly pick-up, your share will be donated to charity.

We encourage you to register soon since we have numerous returning customers and several new customers interested in this popular program.

Listed are the expected fruit and vegetables we plan to provide for the 12 week period.

May Produce:

Asparagus, cabbage, strawberries, spring onions, sweet onions, red potatoes, sweet potatoes, tomatoes, garden peas, beets, broccoli, carrots, cauliflower, kale, radish and lettuce

June Produce:

Yellow squash, patty-pan squash, zucchini squash, sweet potatoes, red potatoes, beets, sweet onions, carrots, cucumbers (slicers, pickles and burpless), tomatoes (slicer and grape), lettuce, cauliflower, blueberries and peaches.

July Produce:

Squash, zucchini, eggplant, sweet corn, sweet potatoes, red potatoes, cucumbers, tomatoes, okra, cantaloupe, watermelons, peppers(bell, banana and hot), snap beans, butter beans, lettuce, collards, blueberries and peaches
